



E-Learning Students Expectations 2020-2021 School Year

Definition of E-Learning: Student learning opportunity using WJ teachers and ODE curriculum, in lieu of the student participating in a Brick & Mortar setting.

Goal of E-Learning: The goal of E-Learning is to ensure student learning continues outside of the Brick & Mortar setting.

WJMS/WJHS E-Learning Plan Includes the Following:

- **Clear Expectations:**
 - Each content classroom teacher will establish clear expectations to guide students as they engage in E-Learning.
 - Content teacher will establish an office hour every Wednesday, the teacher will utilize "google meet" to provide students the opportunity for support through video conferencing.
 - Student questions should be emailed to the teacher and a response will be provided.
 - Students are expected to routinely check their school emails.
 - Teachers will email a google classroom invite prior to Tuesday, September 8th for you to begin E-Learning on that Tuesday (9/8/2020).
- **Student Instruction:**
 - WJ students will be taught by WJ teachers;
 - WJ students will be taught ODE content standards by WJ teachers;
 - Instruction will be provided through Google classroom (online learning platform);
 - Lesson Plans, video instruction, assignments assigned, assignments submitted, and assessments will be placed/completed on Google Classroom;
 - Students must access their Google classroom daily.
 - Students are required to participate in teachers' Wednesday's office hours.

- Fixed Schedules:
 - Students will have a schedule of classes;
 - Students will participate in the assigned classes, learning from the assigned WJ teacher;
 - Parents will have access to their student's progressbook (Monitor progress).
- Learning Materials:
 - Textbook will be provided (if class uses a textbook);
 - Mrs. Miller will assign high school students a day and time to pick-up their textbooks. Students will not need to enter the building. Students, make sure you are checking your email daily for updates from the high school office.
 - Mrs. Schneider will assign middle school students a day and time to pick up their textbooks and will email parents and students this information. Students should make sure they check their emails daily.
 - Students will have access to all other learning materials through Google classroom.
- Determining Competency and Granting Credit:
 - WJHS students - please refer to page 32 in the Student Handbook (WJHS website);
 - WJMS students - please refer to page 4-5 in the Student Handbook (WJMS website);
 - E-Learning students will be held accountable for their grades, just as the Brick & Mortar students.
- Attendance Requirements:
 - Daily participation in all assigned classes is required;
 - Assignments must be completed by the assigned due date;
 - Attendance:
 - Monitoring attendance on a regular schedule will provide families flexibility for supporting their child(ren)'s completion of E-Learning activities;
 - Students must complete daily entrance/exit tickets assigned by their classroom teacher. If they do not complete their daily entrance/exit ticket, the student will be counted as absent.
 - E-Learning students are accountable for their attendance, just as the Brick & Mortar students. (Must participate daily in Google Classroom and complete assignments on-time).
- Monitoring of Student Progress:
 - The E-Learning students are on WJ teachers' rosters, so they are responsible for their learning. (Just like Brick & Mortar students);
 - Parents/E-Learning Students are required to access Progressbook to monitor their grades;
 - Two-way communication between school and home is vital.
