CALL TO ORDER

ROLL CALL

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

Questions & Answers – Mr. Daulton/Mr. Adams Regarding Athletics/Boosters

Mr. Daulton and Mr. Adams answered questions from the Board regarding the management of the athletic department. Topics included booster involvement, sport budgets, hall of fame process, etc.

Mr. Ingles discussed the proposed coach pay schedule.

Confirm Washington D.C. Trip

Mr. Adams will continue planning for the 8th Grade Washington, DC trip.

Review and Establish new goals for Superintendent/Treasurer

Review of 2021-2022 goals was postponed to the next work session.

Mr. Ingles and Mr. Mullett will collaborate on a joint goal of developing an administrative pay scale.

Mr. Mullett may update his previous goal of growth and facilities with recent court decisions regarding development.

Review of Open Enrollment Program

Mr. Mullett reviewed the current policy of allowing existing students open enroll if they move to a neighboring district. The Board supports continuing this policy.

Payroll Questions

Mr. Ingles answered questions regarding payroll practices. Specifically, the practice of paying teachers a substitute rate for covering periods. Mr. Ingles will research options to streamline that process and discuss with Mr. Adams. An electronic timesheet system was discussed for payroll exceptions. Mr. Ingles discussed previous research into such systems but will see what is currently available.

November 8th Substitute Levy Planning

Mr. Mullett discussed the strategies used in the past. The levy fund pays for all materials.
